- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 5.3% since 2019, growing by 10,357. Population is expected to increase by 5.8% between 2024 and 2029, adding 11,801.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 8.5% in 6 South Dakota Counties from 99,419 to 107,877. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.1% by 4.4%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 60.8% to 64.1% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **21.4% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (0.1% below the national average), and **11.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, and Federal Government, Civilian.




Apr 2025 Labor Force Breakdown









Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends






Millennials
















Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration







Educational Pipeline

In 2023, there were 1,907 graduates in 6 South Dakota Counties. This pipeline has shrunk by 25% over the last 5 years.
